## Powerful Station Scheduled | De for Operation in August

Washington, June 28.—The Indian Broadcasting Company intends to begin broadcasting from its new 12-kilowatt station now under construction in August of this year, according to advices from Vice-Consul William H. Beach, **Bombay**, made public by the Department of Commerce. Thus far, broadcasting in **Bombay** has been done by the **Bombay Presidency Radio Club**, with its low-powered station operating on a wave length of 387 metres. It is expected in India that the opening of the new station will stimulate the sale of radio sets in **Bombay**.
